Kindergarten will be celebrating the 100th day of school. Be sure to ask your child if they can count by ten's to one hundred and count by one's to 100! 1st Grade is excited to celebrate Read Across America and all of the wonderful books by Dr. Seuss. We are beginning a Time & Measurement unit in Math and continuing with Place Value. Look for information coming home about Animal Reports and speeches.

2nd Grade has completed their math unit on adding and subtracting double digit numbers with regrouping. This is a very difficult task for many students so please continue to practice at home. We have started a new reading unit on how the earth changes, including land regions such as a rain forest, volcanoes, earthquakes, and erosion. It is conference time once again. We will use the same scheduled time as in the fall. Please call the office with any time conflicts. It is also the time of the year when school supplies begin to dwindle or become used up. Please ask your child if there are any additional school supplies he or she made need at this time.
