Grade Level News

Kindergarten

Kindergarteners are gearing up for fall! Mother Goose has visited and asked us to look for her little people who live in her land! We'll be making pumpkins, leaves and scarecrows to get ready for fall! EDK begins this month. Please continue to have your child start the day with a full stomach and ready to learn behavior. Thanks for a great start to our school year by coming to open house!

1st Grade

First grade has been very busy! We are working on Daily 5, reading groups, short vowels, and personal narratives in writing. In math, we are working on number sense and addition and subtraction and enjoying all of the fun math games that come with learning our math facts. October is filled with Fall activities as we gear up for a fun "Monster Mash" on October 31st.

2nd Grade

In reading we discussed and read about friends, families, different cultures and pets. We are working on fluency and using text evidence to answer comprehension questions. Using good penmanship we are writing friendly letters, complete sentences, and practicing spelling words. In grammar we are identifying subjects, and learning plural noun spelling. After completing our first module in math which was mental math and 2-3 digit problems, we are measuring using standard and metric units. Not only are we the Sage Owls but second graders now know all about owls as we researched and learned about all types of owls. Sunriver Nature Center provided hand-on explorations and a visit from a Great Horned Owl.

3rd Grade

Third grade will study character traits culminating in book character day. Book character day will take place at the end of the month.

4th Grade

Fourth graders are currently learning about place value in math and what it really means to move on the place value chart. In English language arts we are reading about natural disasters and asking ourselves, "How do people respond to natural disasters?" In the social sciences we have started to look at geography by studying the Parts of a Map, Globe Lines, and the Four Hemispheres. In addition, we have started an investigation into the first people of Oregon.

5th Grade

Fifth grade is fearless as we are entering October! We are getting "Fired Up" about exploring the High Desert Museum this month, as well as the Bend Science Station! Yes, that is right, we are excited to have 2 upcoming field trips! Oh, the places we will go...
