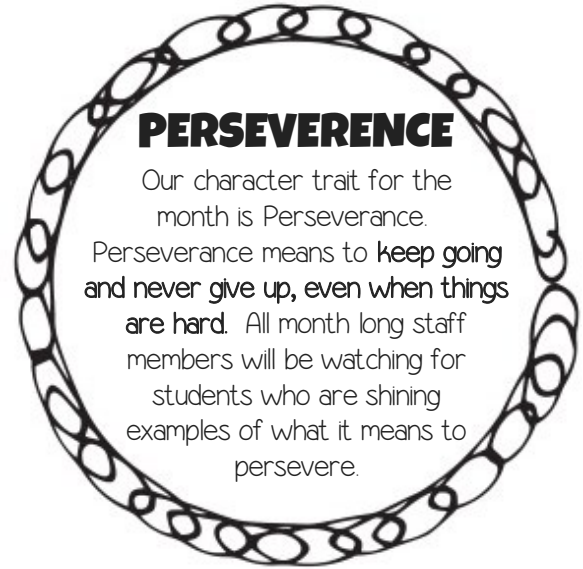

WOW AWARDS

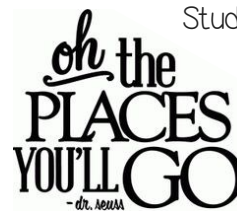
