When your child has been sick, the RSD policy is that your child is not to return to school until 24 hours have passed with no fever, diarrhea, or vomiting; and without the use of medication.

Ex: If your child is sent home on Tues with a fever, they are not to return until Thursday, IF they were symptom-free on Wednesday.
