

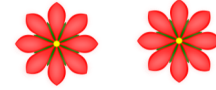

A NOTE FROM YOUR SCHOOL NURSE



➔ We are almost through the cold & flu season. Bring on the sunshine and warmer weather! Thank you for doing your best to adhere to district policies and keeping your sick student at home. Students should stay home until they have been without a fever for 24 hours and without the use of medicine. Also, if your student has been vomiting or has had diarrhea, they should not return to school until they have been 24 hours free from symptoms.

➔ Please do not send medicine to school with your student. Any medicine that your student needs to take during the school day will require you to fill out a medical authorization form in the office. This includes cough drops!

Lice. District policy does not allow students with live lice to come to school until they have been treated. Students with nits (the eggs) may attend school. Whole class head checks are completed if 3 non-

➔ related cases of head lice are reported within a 10 day period. It is EXTREMELY important that you notify the school if your child has head lice so we can adhere to district policy! Spread the word, not the lice! Thank you for your help!



2018 YEARBOOKS

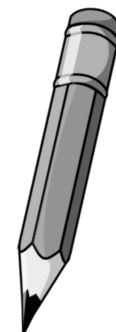
Yearbooks will be distributed in late May. Limited quantities are still available. Visit the Sage Office to reserve your copy! \$20 each.
