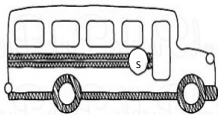
Birthday Treats

The Redmond School District will have a bond measure on the November 6, 2018 ballot. Things you need to know for the November election:

- 1: Redmond Schools will be on the ballot officially as Measure 9-125. If passed...
- 2: The bond will invest 70 million in Redmond Schools including **Sage!**
- 3: We will prioritize safety and security
- 4: We will modernize classrooms
- 5: We will upgrade and update schools
- 6: M.A. Lynch school will be replaced

So, what does this mean for Sage? The proposed projects for our school are:

- Install camera coverage at playground
- Install key card access to main entrance
- Install access control system
- Add AC to second floor classrooms
